Course: Intensive English 1

Credits : Non- credit course

Hours: 45 hrs.

Course Description:

The course focuses on EFL four skills using a communicative approach and sources. The ultimate goal of the course using this approach is to enhance students' interaction both in classroom setting and outside of the classroom. Thus, activities and tasks are designed to practice language successfully through having to communicate real meaning. The students are expected to be able to interact with each other and the instructor will be considered as a facilitator.

1. Course Objectives:

In this course, students are able to communicate in English; however, they make many mistakes in expressing themselves and understanding others. Therefore, students will focus on their English skills including listening, speaking, reading, and writing as they are very limited users of English. Hopefully, the course can improve their proficiency especially in speaking and encourage them to incorporate their personal experiences fluently.

2. Learning Outcome:

It is expected that, on completion of this course, the students will be able to:

1. speak fluently about familiar topics likely with frequent mistakes and handle basic communication.
2. read independently and copy the overall meaning in basic reading passages.
3. listen and copy general meaning in most familiar situations.
4. write about familiar topics with inaccuracies.
5. demonstrate some grammatical accuracies in familiar situations.
6. use proper vocabulary while writing and speaking in familiar situations.
