**Course: Intensive English 2      Credits: Non- credit course      Hours: 45 hrs.**

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**Course Description:**

The course focuses on EFL four skills using a communicative language teaching approach. The ultimate goal of the course is to foster communication skills in authentic contexts and encourage learners to use language for real life purposes fluently. Scaffolding will be used to increase the complexity of the progress to more challenging situations to improve the students confidence.

**1. Course Objectives:**

In this course, students will be able to improve their English language proficiency by practicing real life situations. The tasks are designed to practice the required language use to achieve A2 level according to CEFR. Therefore, they will be engaged in activities that will help them communicate more fluently, exchange information, describe aspects of their background or their immediate environment, and explain matters related to immediate needs. In addition, students will get familiar with language use to be able to interact in social settings.

**2. Learning Outcome:**

It is expected that, on completion of this course, the students will be able to:

1. speak fluently about extended familiar topics more fluently.
2. read independently and copy the overall meaning in long familiar reading passages.
3. listen and find details in most familiar situations.
4. write extensively about familiar topics.
5. demonstrate fewer grammatical accuracies in familiar situations.
6. use proper vocabulary extensively while writing and speaking in familiar situations.
