The University Code of Ethics

Siam University's Code of Ethics provide guiding principles for the University Council, administrators, faculty members, staff, and students. According to the Administrative Meeting on July 21st, 2026. It encompasses the following five key principles:

1. Integrity and Good Governance

- 1.1 Perform all duties with honesty, integrity, transparency, and accountability.
- 1.2 Avoid corruption, conflicts of interest, and the misuse of authority or resources.
- 1.3 Ensure responsible and efficient use of university assets for the benefit of the institution and society.

2. Academic and Professional Responsibility

- 2.1 Uphold excellence in teaching, learning, research, and academic services.
- 2.2 Adhere to the highest standards of research integrity, avoiding plagiarism, fabrication, and other forms of academic misconduct.
- 2.3 Promote academic freedom while exercising professional responsibility and ethical judgment.

3. Respect for Human Dignity, Equality, and Diversity

- 3.1 Treat every individual with respect, fairness, and dignity regardless of background or identity.
- 3.2 Foster an inclusive environment free from discrimination, harassment, bullying, and intimidation.
- 3.3 Promote mutual respect, collaboration, and equal opportunities for all members of the university community.

4. Social Responsibility and Sustainability

- 4.1 Recognize the university's responsibility to society, local communities, and the environment.
- 4.2 Support sustainable development and contribute to the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- 4.3 Demonstrate ethical leadership and a commitment to serving the public good.

5. Digital and Artificial Intelligence (AI) Ethics

- 5.1 Use digital technologies and artificial intelligence responsibly, transparently, and ethically.

- 5.2 Protect privacy, confidentiality, data security, and intellectual property rights.
- 5.3 Ensure that AI is used to enhance education, research, and administration while maintaining human oversight, fairness, accountability, and compliance with ethical and legal standards.
